

Ravi Shankar Prasad exhorts Indian community in France

'Singapore stands with India against terrorism'

BJP MP Ravi Shankar Prasad exhorted members of the Indian community in France to make every effort to showcase Brand India as a beacon of peace that is fighting against the global curse of terrorism.

Addressing a gathering of community leaders and prominent members of the Indian diaspora in Paris on Monday evening, an all-party parliamentary delegation led by Prasad conveyed the message that the terrorist attack in Pahalgam last month was a deliberate attempt to undermine peace and development in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

India's response with Operation Sindoor was "precise, targeted, proportionate and non-escalatory" and targeted at Pakistan-backed terrorist camps.

When I see the growth of India, I am very proud of all of you because you are the brand ambassadors (of the country)," said Prasad. "Please properly showcase Brand India, that we are for peace, we are for amity. But if innocent Indians are killed by terrorists, they will have to pay a cost. That is the winning Operation Sindoor," he said.

Sindoor is not just a conventional fight back. It will be a fight back in all its forms, in all its possibilities, and in all the spaces possible for India to tell the world, and to especially tell Pakistan, that we will hold you to account for every single life that an Indian loses because of your terrorism," she said.

"In Pakistan, terrorism is not a maverick activity. It is not the activity of a criminal class which may exist in any country. Terrorism is a state policy," said former union minister of state M J Akbar.

Singapore strongly condemns all acts of terrorism and stands with India against the menace, a senior minister of the city-state told an all-party Indian parliamentary delegation on Tuesday.

The delegation, led by JD(U) Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Kumar Jha, which arrived here from South Korea, met Senior Minister of State for Foreign Affairs and Home Affairs Sim Ann and briefed her on India's stance on the events since the terror attack in Pahalgam, Operation Sindoor, and the new normal in India's strategy against terrorism.

She also said that Singapore and India are close partners and will continue efforts to further strengthen bilateral cooperation, it added.

The all-party delegation conveyed that if there is a terrorist attack on India, New Delhi will give a fitting reply. "India will not tolerate any nuclear blackmail. India will strike precisely and decisively at the terrorist hideouts developing under the cover of nuclear blackmail. India will not differentiate between the government sponsoring terrorism and the masterminds of terrorism," it said.

As close friends and partners, India and Singapore will continue to work closely on regional and global issues, including terrorism, it said.

Jha highlighted that the delegation brings representatives of different political parties together to convey India's united resolve against terrorism.

The delegation members conveyed that the terrorist attack in Pahalgam was an attempt to disturb the trajectory of peace, development, and normalcy in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the statement said. The Government of

India deemed it essential that the perpetrators and planners of the April 22 terror attack be brought to justice. In response to this heinous act of terror, India launched Operation Sindoor, targeting the terrorist infrastructure. India's response was measured, non-escalatory, proportionate, and responsible, it said.

The delegation also called on Minister of Law and Second Minister of Home Affairs Edwin Tong. Later, addressing a press conference, delegation member Mohan Kumar, a former ambassador to France and Bahrain, said that the all-party delegation that visited Japan, South Korea, and Singapore told these countries that at no time the conflict between India and Pakistan was going into nuclear.

"There was never a minute we thought that the conflict might go nuclear," he said. Dismissing narratives that the potential use of nuclear weapons in the conflict had worried investors, Kumar reiterated India's commitment to economic development.

"We will not let any incident like this (conflict) affect India's growth and become a \$10 trillion economy," he said. The delegation also met with senior representatives from the Singaporean government, academia, media, and business. Delegation members briefed Singaporean interlocutors on the developments since the Pahalgam terror attack and India's new normal in combating terrorism.

"We appreciate the presence of Senior Minister of State Mr Jani Puthucheary and Members of Parliament Mr Vikram Nair and Mr Saktiandi Supaat," the mission posted on X. The delegation also briefed the Institute of South Asian Studies, a think tank at the National University of Singapore, and met with the Indian community, giving them an overview of the incident and India's firm stand on terrorism.

The delegation is one of the seven multi-party delegations India has tasked to visit 33 global capitals to reach out to the international community to emphasise Pakistan's links to terrorism and assert that the recent conflict was triggered by the Pahalgam terror strike and not Operation Sindoor, as alleged by Islamabad.

Tensions between India and Pakistan escalated after the Pahalgam terror attack, with India carrying out precision strikes on terror infrastructure in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir in the early hours of May 7.

Pakistan attempted to attack Indian military bases on May 8, 9 and 10. The Indian side responded strongly to the Pakistani actions. The on-ground hostilities ended with an understanding of stopping the military actions following talks between the directors general of military operations of both sides on May 10.
